

Marriages at Skegby,

1569 to 1812.

NOTE.—It may be mentioned that Skegby was anciently a chapelry in the parish of Mansfield. The Registers of this parish before 1813 may be thus described.

Vol. I.

This Volume is of parchment, without cover, and appears to be two books sewn together. The smaller portion measures 8 inches by 5½ inches; the larger 9 inches by 5½ inches. Half of the last leaf (recording baptisms and burials, and possibly some weddings also) is gone. In some places the ink has faded so completely, that a few of the entries are totally illegible. Handwriting generally beautifully clear and neat, and very closely written.

Vol. II. 1676-1750.

This Volume is without a cover, and consists of 35 parchment leaves irregular in size. Average measurement 14 inches by 7 inches. The leaves are discoloured and in places the ink is very faint. The first leaf is torn in several places. The entries are in the handwriting of several different people, and in some cases are mixed up with baptisms and burials.

Vol. III. 1750-1812.

This Volume is bound in calf. The cover measures 14½ inches by 8¾ inches, and it is in rather poor condition. The leaves are of parchment measuring 14 inches by 8½ inches. The title on the cover is to some extent indecipherable, apparently eaten through by the ink:

“A Register of the Baptisms, Marriages, and Burials in
[*word gone*] in the County of Nottingham, in the
Archdeaconry of '*word gone*' and Diocese of York.”

The pages number 73, and are in places much discoloured. The marriages and banns are entered together in two places.
