William Lyle and Sarah Blankenship were born and married in Smith Co. (later Macon Co.) Tenn. and lived there until 1861, when they came to Schuyler Co., Mo. where they lived 2 years, then went to Randolph Co., Mo. where they spent the remainder of their lives. Most of the family are buried in the cemetery at Clifton Hills in Randolph Co.
